HOSTEL DECLARATION & HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE STUDENTS

The rules and regulations, as follows, are framed to ensure that the hostelproperty is protected; student staying in the hostel is comfortable in a conducive environment for healthy living and discipline is maintained amongst the inmates.

1. The Student is required to disclose all past medical history. Any nondisclosure of past medical history is at the risk of the student.

2. The student shall pay Hostel fee for one year as onetime payment, along withinterest free refundable deposit in advance at the time of admission. The term for hostel fee is one academic year as per the academic calendar of the res institute.

3. Room allotment shall be done by the authorities. Students shall not interchangetheir room with another into vacant room/ bed without prior written permissionfrom the Rector/ Warden. The Rector/ Warden have the right to shift any studentfrom his/her room to another room in the hostel.

4. No right in nature of tenancy or any other like right is created by occupation oruse of hostel premises and property. A student is merely permitted to temporarilystay in the hostel, under the rules and regulations framed by the Institute, from timeto time.

5 Provision of hostel accommodation at the time of admission does notautomatically ensure its continuation in the subsequent years. The student has toapply every year for admission. Admission can be denied to students for lowacademic performance and those indulging in acts of indiscipline.

6 The Student is personally responsible for safety of their all valuables.

7. The student shall not bring any extra furniture or other fixture in the room.

8. All furniture and fixture in the rooms allotted to the student must be cared forproperly. The student will be required to pay double the original cost if any item isfound damaged or missing from their room due to careless / negligent handling. The student will also be required to pay twice the charges of the repair of an item that is found to have been willfully damaged or have been damaged on account ofmisuse or unfair wear and tear.

9 Student is prohibited from interchanging any furniture/fixture from onepoint/location in the hostel to another. Besides a penal recovery as imposed bywarden /Rector, students involved in such activities may be expelled from thehostel.

10. Theft/damage to hostel assets in common areas/corridors will be recovered from all students of the flank/wing involved. In case of theft/damage to items that pertain to usage by the complete hostel, the recoveries will be made from all theoccupants of the hostel.

11 Electric appliances shall not be permitted in the room, defiance of which shallenable the Rector/ Warden to confiscate the gadget forthwith.

12. The lights in the bathroom should be used only as and when necessary andshall be switched off, when the bathroom is not in use.

13. While leaving the room, students should take care to switch off the lights and fans without fail. In case of default on this account, a reasonable fine per defaultoccasion will be imposed by the warden /Rector.

14. The student should not leave taps open when the taps are dry, as it will result in

Subsequent loss of water and further aggravate the water problem.

15. The Hostel Wardens or any other Officials of the institute along with SecurityGuards may at their discretion inspect /check any room or students belongingsliving there in any time of the day or night.

16. A student shall have to vacate the hostel within five days of completion ofher/his examination or any such academic requirement, whichever is later. Anyextra day will be charged as per norms and for such extra days, prior writtenpermission from the Rector/ Warden is required.

17. In case a student does not vacate her/his room, the belongings will be removed from the room and room will be locked by the Warden/ Rector with noresponsibility of the Management for the loss, if any. Also a strict disciplinary action shall be initiated against such disobedience.

18. The Institute/ Rector/Warden reserves the right to terminate the temporaryoccupancy of the student for any willful disobedience or defiance of authority,non-observance of hostel rules, causing damage to person or property or indulgingin anti-social, anti-national or undesirable activities. In such cases the deposit shallbe forfeited and hostel fee will NOT be refunded.

19. Students expelled from the institutes will also be expelled from the hostel andhostel fee will not be refunded.

20. During the vacation, belongings should be kept in the store room under lockand key.

21. On completion of the final year of the programme or when a student vacateshostel at the end of an academic year, he/she should take all his/her belongingswith him/her.

22. Attendance fills between 8:00 pm 9:00 pm every night. Each boarder has topersonally sign the attendance register / biometric attendance record every daybetween 8:00 pm 9:00 pm. After such prescribed time, the student is not allowed togo out of the hostel. Going out of the hostel will lead to a disciplinary action.

23. The student shall return to the hostel before prescribed time after which gateswill be closed. The gates will reopen at 6.00 a.m. the next day. Late comers willhave to make an entry in the register kept at the gate, which will be informed to his/ her parents and local guardians. Three late coming entries will lead tocancellation of permission to stay in hostel and fee will not be refunded.

24. The student is permitted to go outstation for participating in variouscompetitions only after submitting proof and application through head ofdepartment /concerned faculty to the Rector/Warden and getting permission of theRector/Warden. The student will intimate the Warden and make an entry in theOutstation Register kept with the Warden.

25. The student shall take prior permission of the Warden /Rector for celebratingany festivals. Birthday celebration not allowed in hostel. There should not be anykind of discomfort to other students. No outside guest or interference of any kindwill be allowed.

26. Night out shall be permitted by the Rector/Warden only under followingconditions and circumstances:

1. When permitted in writing by the Warden for academic reasons.

2. On holidays with written consent from parents/local guardian.

27. Once night out permission is accorded; student will be permitted to report onlyafter 6.00 am in the morning. However, in case of medical emergency student cancontact the warden directly.

28.The students will always carry their hostel Identity cards when moving out of the Campus, so that in case of an emergency/accident the institute can be contacted and informed. The student's not carrying Identity card with him/her will bereported to the Warden for action.

29. No student shall keep talking with visitors in compound, either in or outside thegate/lane. No student shall take any visitor including her/his parents to the room.Personal servants/domestic helpers are not allowed inside the rooms. The parentsshould give an undertaking to cooperate with the authority and should be availableon call.

30. Mess is compulsory for the hostellers, outside tiffin is strictly prohibited.**Students has to deposit** advance of Mess fees of six months at college administration before residing at hostel.

31. No food will be served in the rooms of the hostel for any student unlessa certificate is produced form the Medical Officer to the effect that thestudents' condition requires the food to be served in their rooms.

32. Students are not permitted to cook any food on their own accord in themesses or in their rooms.

33. No student can claim mess reduction unless he/she had intimated his/herabsence to the concerned warden/ mess manager in advance and got prior writtenapproval.

34. A Mess Committee comprising of Rector, Warden, Faculty and students ofconcerned hostel will be constituted. The mess committee will decide the menu, check food quality from time to time, maintain a record of such inspections and give feedback for improvement of food quality and other aspects of mess and dining.

35. Only members of the mess are permitted to dine in the mess. Outside food /dabbas are strictly forbidden in the Mess. Members are expected to inform theirabsence/dining out or night out to the Mess Supervisor well in advance, to avoidwastage of food.

36. Guests are allowed in mess only with prior permission and on payment of charges applicable.

37. The students should be decently dressed when they are out of room. For girls, tight body hugging clothes, short tops, revealing clothes etc. are forbidden outside the room.

38. Strict silence shall be observed in hostel from 12.00 midnight to 6.00 am. Careshall be taken at all times to ensure that music/loud talking is NOT audible outside the room.

39. Any manner of festivities and noise making/celebrations, which may causedisturbance to other inmates in the hostel premises, will not be allowed.

40. The student shall keep their rooms, verandah and surrounding areas tidy, neatand clean at all times and shall not throw anything including trash, in such placesor any premises in the hostel, except in the dustbin or the place specificallyprovided for the said purpose.

41. No wet clothes should be dried on the furniture or in corridors/ balconies. Thewarden may confiscate any such clothes hung for drying in the balconies. Nostudent shall store any cooked food in the room.

42. The student shall treat the staff and housekeeping staff of the Hostel with duecourtesy at all times. Service of the housekeeping staff shall NOT be utilized forprivate or personal work. No tips in cash or kind should be given to the staff of theHostel.

43. Ragging in any form whatsoever is strictly BANNED. It is a cognizable offence and violation will invite action as per law of the land, in addition to expulsion from the institute.

44. Being a silent spectator and not reporting/stopping others indulging in raggingis also an offence and will invite similar disciplinary action.

45. Accepting/undergoing ragging and not reporting this is also an offence.Students should report any such incident immediately to any member of the AntiRagging Committee / Warden / Principal / Rector directly at any time of the day /night.

46. The student shall not bring, store, possess, consume and/or drink any alcohol/intoxicating drink, drug or substance of any kind what so ever and/or smoke in theroom and/or any part of premises. An occurrence of such behavior shall invitestrict disciplinary action leading to expulsion from Hostel, rustication from theInstitute and action as per law of land.

47. No gambling of any kind whatsoever shall be allowed on the premises of thehostel. Any violation of this Rule violation will invite action as per law of the land, in addition to expulsion from the institute.

48. Any act of uploading derogatory remarks or image ridiculing a person in eyesof other against the Institute or any other person or organization will invitedisciplinary action. Student should strictly refrain from indulging in any act ofviolating the code of internet use.

49. The student shall not indulge in any political or communal activity which isdetrimental to the law and order and/or against the Government. Students shall notcarry on any propaganda or publicity of any nature whatsoever in respect of anypolitical or communal matters.

50. The student shall take prior written permission of the Warden /Rector/principalbefore giving any information or interview regarding Hostel to any member of thePress, Print Media, Radio, Television or any other media or before making anyspeech containing any information regarding the Hostel.

51. Any type of storage or possession of firearm, ammunition, explosive and inflammable goods on the premises of the hostel is strictly prohibited. Violation of the rule will lead to expulsion from hostel and institute.

52. The student shall not bring and/or keep any pets in the premises including fish, cats, dogs, and so on. Student should desist from pampering stray dogs by offeringfood, petting them etc.

53. In addition to penalties, punishment and fine provided in these Rules, Disciplinary action as per institute shall be taken against student violating theseHostel Rules and Regulations.

54. If any common property is lost/damaged/disfigured, the loss will be recovered from the students, in equal share, who are responsible for the damage or loss or ingeneral use of that property. In case the damage/loss cannot be pinpointed tostudent(s), then collective fine to recover the loss will be levied by the Campus

Administrator.
